NOTICE

It is notified for the information of all concerned that in implementation of Judgment dated 15.12.2014 of the Supreme Court of India passed in Civil Appeal No.5838-39/2012 titled 'K.K. Sharma & Ors. Vs. High Court of Delhi & Ors' and Judgments dated 23.10.2009 and 01.06.2012 of this Court passed in W.P. (C). No.4077-84/2004 titled 'Atul Kumar Sharma & Ors. Vs. High Court of Delhi', and on the recommendations of the concerned Hon'ble Committee, Hon'ble the Chief Justice of this Court has been pleased to order that a special review departmental test be held for filling up 8 posts of Senior Judicial Assistant on notional basis for such officials who were eligible between the period 1988 to 2000.

Accordingly, it is hereby circulated for information of the officers/ officials of this Court and officers/officials of Courts subordinate to this Court, that it is proposed to hold a special review departmental test for filling up 08 posts of Senior Judicial Assistant on notional basis.

The eligible officers/ officials of this Court and the Courts subordinate to this Court, who fulfilled the requisite qualification and were eligible between the period 1988 to 2000, i.e. from 01.01.1988 to 31.12.2000 and desire to appear in the special review departmental test, may submit their applications online giving full particulars of their service and educational qualifications as prescribed in the online format on or before 31.07.2017 on the website of this Court viz. www.delhihighcourt.nic.in under the link **Public Notice-Job Openings**.

Note:

1. All the candidates shall apply online only. No application in physical form shall be entertained and all such applications shall be outrightly rejected without any further notice to such candidates.
2. Candidates working in subordinate courts or who have retired from subordinate courts, in addition to the online application, must also forward a printout of the application submitted through online mode duly forwarded by the competent authority, **after certifying the particulars filled in**. In case, the duly forwarded copy is not received in the Examination Branch by 05.08.2017, the candidature is liable to be rejected.

The Rule, as per Item 8 of Schedule II of Delhi High Court Establishment (Conditions of Service) Rules 1972 prescribing the qualifications and eligibility for appearing in the exam for the post of Senior Judicial Assistant, during the relevant period (2000) reads as under:-

Written Paper-II **Marks: 100** **Duration: 3 Hours.**

- i. Drafting - 50 marks
- ii. Office Noting - 50 marks

Interview **Marks: 50**

Candidates who obtain 40% marks in each of the written papers will be called for interview and only those candidates will be considered qualified for appointment as Senior Judicial Assistant/ Reader/ Court Officer, who secure 40% marks in aggregate of the marks prescribed for written test and interview.

Note:-

1. It is clarified that circular No.1073/Estt/E-IV/DHC dated 22.12.2010 issued earlier in this regard stands cancelled and the officers/ officials who had applied in response to the said circular need to apply afresh for consideration of their candidature for appearing in the exam for the post of Senior Judicial Assistant.
2. Only such officials who were eligible to appear in the exam for the post of Senior Judicial Assistant during the period 1988 – 2000 i.e. (from 01.01.1988 to 31.12.2000) alone will be permitted to compete in the exam.
3. The applications lacking the required information/particulars shall be liable to be rejected.
