

**The terms & conditions of this tender are as under:-**

1. Sealed envelope containing quotation must reach to the AOJ (IT & Stationery Branch), Lawyer's Chamber Block-III, Room No. 6, Ground Floor, Delhi High Court on or before 22.02.2021 till 5:00P.M. clearly mentioning the technical details and online/onsite technical support of the product being offered. **Quotations for products other than specified above will be summarily rejected.**
2. The validity of rates should not be less than 180 days from the last date of submission of quotation and tax/GST rate applicable should be clearly & separately mentioned.
3. **Quotations with less period of validity of rates shall be summarily rejected.**
4. The envelope should be addressed in the name of "The Registrar General, Delhi High Court, New Delhi" and the subject "**Quotation for annual subscription of Adobe Creative Cloud All apps**" should be superscribed on the envelope. Tenderers are also directed to specify the name of the firm and contact details on the Envelope.
5. No quotations shall be entertained **after due date.** Envelope(s) **without subject** shall be summarily rejected.
6. It may be noted that the final rates should be mentioned as unit price inclusive of GST and taxes applicable should be clearly and separately mentioned.
7. If multiple quotations submitted by a firm/vendor, all such quotations submitted shall liable to be rejected at the first instance.
8. After opening of the sealed quotation if any correction is found in the offered rate which renders the whole Tender process doubtful or ambiguous, the said quotation shall be summarily rejected.
