**Notes:-**

1. The judicial officers shall be under the control of the Principal District & Sessions Judge of the district to which they have been allocated.
2. The judicial officers under transfer shall notify the cases in which they had reserved judgments/orders before relinquishing the charge of the court in terms of the posting/transfer order. The judicial officers shall pronounce judgments/orders in all such matters on the date fixed or maximum within a period of 2-3 weeks thereof, notwithstanding the posting/transfer. Date of pronouncement shall be notified in the cause list of the court to which the matter pertains as also of the court to which the judicial officer has been transferred and on the website.

3. The Principal District & Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge (PC Act)(CBI), RACC shall take steps for assignment of cases to the newly created Labour Courts of PO Labour Court-07, PO Labour Court-08 and PO Labour Court-09.
4. The court of PO, Labour Court presided over by Ms. Veena Rani is re-designated as PO, Labour Court-01; the court of PO, Labour Court IX presided over by Mr. Pawan Kumar Matto is re-designated as PO, Labour Court-02; the court of PO, Labour Court XVI erstwhile presided over by Mr. Anil Kumar is re-designated as PO, Labour Court-03; the court of PO, Labour Court XIX erstwhile presided over by Mr. Lokesh Kumar Sharma is re-designated as PO, Labour Court-04; the court of PO, Labour Court V erstwhile presided over by Mr. Vinay Singhal is re-designated as PO, Labour Court-05; and the court of PO, Labour Court presided over by Mr. Ramesh Kumar-II is re-designated as PO, Labour Court-06.
5. The court of ASJ-05(POCSO), Central, THC hitherto presided over by Mr. Mohd. Farrukh stands abolished. The Principal District & Sessions Judge (HQ), THC shall assign the cases under the POCSO Act from the court of ASJ-05(POCSO), Central THC to the two newly created courts of ASJ(FTSC)(POCSO) -01 and ASJ(FTSC)(POCSO) -02 (which are Special Courts for trial of cases under the POCSO Act) and the other cases to other courts of competent jurisdiction, so as to ensure equal pendency. The Principal District & Sessions Judge (HQ), THC shall also withdraw sufficient number of cases from the court of ASJ-01 (POCSO) and assign them to the said new courts, so as to ensure equal pendency.
6. The Principal District & Sessions Judge (HQ), THC shall withdraw sufficient number of rape cases from the court of ASJ (Special Fast Track Court) presided over by Mr. Satish Kumar and assign them to the newly created court of ASJ(FTSC)(RC), Central, THC so as to ensure equal pendency.
7. The Principal District & Sessions Judge (HQ), THC shall withdraw sufficient number of cases from the existing courts of ASJs in the district and assign them to the newly created court of ASJ-05, Central, THC so as to ensure equal pendency.
8. The court of Special Judge, Electricity Court presided over by Mr. Vidya Prakash shall be re-designated as Special Judge, Electricity Court-01, Central, THC. The Principal District & Sessions Judge (HQ), THC shall withdraw the cases of BSES-Yamuna Power Limited (BYPL) and Tata Power Delhi Distribution Limited (TPDDL) from the Court of Special Judge, Electricity Court presided over by Mr. Vidya Prakash and assign the same to the newly created court of Special Judge, Electricity Court-02, Central, THC.
9. The Principal District & Sessions Judge (HQ), THC shall withdraw sufficient number of cases from the existing courts of ADJs in the district and assign them to the two newly created courts of ADJ-09, Central, THC and ADJ-10, Central, THC so as to ensure equal pendency.
10. The court of ASJ-09 (POCSO), West, THC hitherto presided over by Mr. Gorakh Nath Pandey stands abolished. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, West, THC shall assign the cases under the POCSO Act from the court of ASJ-09(POCSO), West, THC to the two newly created courts of ASJ(FTSC)(POCSO)-01 and ASJ(FTSC)(POCSO)-02 (which are Special Courts for trial of cases under the POCSO Act) and the other cases to other courts of competent jurisdiction so as to ensure equal pendency. The Principal District & Sessions Judge West, THC shall also withdraw sufficient number of cases from the courts of ASJ-01 (POCSO), ASJ-06 (POCSO) and ASJ-07 (POCSO) and assign them to the said new courts, so as to ensure equal pendency.
11. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, West, THC shall withdraw sufficient number of rape cases from the court of ASJ (Special Fast Track Court) presided over by Mr. Ankur Jain and assign them to the two newly created courts of ASJ(FTSC)(RC)-01, West, THC and ASJ(FTSC)(RC)-02, West, THC (which are Special Courts for trial of rape cases), so as to ensure equal pendency.
12. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, West THC shall withdraw sufficient number of cases from the existing courts of ASJs in the district and assign them to the newly created court of ASJ-09, West, THC so as to ensure equal pendency.

13. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, West, THC shall withdraw sufficient number of cases from the existing courts of ADJs in the district and assign them to the two newly created courts of ADJ-06, West, THC and ADJ-07, West, THC so as to ensure equal pendency.
14. The court of ASJ-05 (POCSO), South, Saket hitherto presided over by Ms. Jyoti Kler stands abolished. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, South, Saket shall assign the cases under the POCSO Act in the Court of ASJ-05, South, Saket to the newly created court of ASJ(FTSC)(POCSO) (which is a Special Court for trial of cases under the POCSO Act) and other cases to other courts of competent jurisdiction, so as to ensure equal pendency.
15. The court of ASJ-07 (POCSO), South-East, Saket hitherto presided over by Mr. Sudhanshu Kaushik stands abolished. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, South-East, Saket shall assign the cases under the POCSO Act in the Court of ASJ-07 (POCSO), South-East, Saket to the newly created court of ASJ(FTSC)(POCSO) (which is a Special Court for trial of cases under the POCSO Act) and the other cases to other courts of competent jurisdiction, so as to ensure equal pendency.
16. The court of ASJ (Special Fast Track Court) -02, East, KKD hitherto presided over by Ms. Navita Kumari Bagha stands abolished. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, East, KKD shall assign the rape cases in the Court of ASJ (Special Fast Track Court) -02, East, KKD to the newly created court of ASJ (FTSC)(RC) (which is a Special Court for trial of rape cases) and the other cases (other than rape cases) to other courts of competent jurisdiction, so as to ensure equal pendency.
17. The court of ASJ (Special Fast Track Court)-01, East, KKD hitherto presided over by Mr. Sanjeev Kumar-I shall be re-designated as ASJ (Special Fast Track Court) , East, KKD.
18. The court of ASJ-05(POCSO), North-West, Rohini hitherto presided over by Mr. Devender Nain stands abolished. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, North-West Rohini shall assign the cases under the POCSO Act from the court of ASJ-05(POCSO), North-West, Rohini to the newly created court of ASJ(FTSC)(POCSO) (which is a Special Court for trial of cases under the POCSO Act) and the other cases to other courts of competent jurisdiction, so as to ensure equal pendency.
19. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, North-West, Rohini shall withdraw sufficient number of cases from the existing courts of ASJs in the district and assign them to the newly created court of ASJ-05, North-West, Rohini, so as to ensure equal pendency.
20. The court of ASJ-06 (POCSO), North, Rohini hitherto presided over by Mr. Neeraj Gaur stands abolished. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, North, Rohini shall assign the cases under the POCSO Act in the Court of ASJ-06(POCSO), North, Rohini to the newly created court of ASJ(FTSC)(POCSO) (which is a Special Court for trial of cases under the POCSO Act) and the other cases to other courts of competent jurisdiction, so as to ensure equal pendency.
21. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, North, Rohini shall withdraw sufficient number of cases from the existing courts of ADJs in the district and assign them to the newly created court of ADJ-04, North, Rohini so as to ensure equal pendency.
22. The courts of ASJ-04(POCSO), South-West, Dwarka hitherto presided over by Mr. Pritam Singh and ASJ-05(POCSO), South-West, Dwarka hitherto presided over by Ms. Gomati Manocha stand abolished. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, South-West, Dwarka shall assign the cases under the POCSO Act from the said courts to the three newly created courts of ASJ(FTSC)(POCSO)-01, ASJ(FTSC)(POCSO)-02 and ASJ(FTSC)(POCSO)-03 (which are Special Courts for trial of cases under the POCSO Act) and the other cases to other courts of competent jurisdiction, so as to ensure equal pendency.
23. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, South-West, Dwarka shall withdraw sufficient number of rape cases from the ASJ (Special Fast Track Court), South-West, Dwarka (presently vacant) and assign them to the newly created court of ASJ(FTSC)(RC), so as to ensure equal pendency.

24. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, South-West, Dwarka shall withdraw sufficient number of cases from the existing courts of ASJs in the district and assign them to the newly created court of ASJ-04, South-West, Dwarka and ASJ-05, South-West, Dwarka so as to ensure equal pendency.
25. The court of PO(MACT), South-West, Dwarka presided over by Mr. Sumedh Kumar Sethi is re-designated as PO(MACT)-01, South-West, Dwarka. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, South-West, Dwarka shall withdraw sufficient number of cases from the said court and assign them to the newly created court of PO(MACT)-02, South-West, Dwarka, so as to ensure equal pendency, under intimation to this Court.


