CIRCULAR

Despite this Court's Circulars No.429/Genl./DHC dated 29.5.14 and No.676/Genl./DHC dated 21.8.14, it has been noticed that the non-automatic vehicles of Advocates, Staff, Litigants and others have been found to be parked in a haphazard manner at deck/surface level as well as input and out-put area of the Underground Automated Multilevel Car Parking, which is meant for automatic vehicles and vehicles for differently abled persons only, resulting in hindrance in parking of legitimate vehicles in the designated lifts.

It is, therefore, impressed upon all the users of automated multilevel underground car parking not to park their vehicles at the surface level. Any vehicle other than SUV/Automated Vehicles or vehicles belonging to differently abled persons found to be parked at the surface level shall be charged with a fine of Rs.500/- per violation of above instructions. The Joint Registrar (Genl. Admn.) shall be the Enforcing Authority for the purpose.

Further no vehicle of any Advocate or staff or any other vehicle shall be allowed to be parked on the Sher Shah Marg and any violating vehicle shall be towed away by the Traffic Police.


